The 2022 meeting will take place at the London School of Economics, UK, from April 21-23, 2022, and is hosted by the Department of Social Policy. The meeting will be in-person and it will be held under the conference theme of

“Social Stratification and Social Policy for a Post-Covid19 World”

Participants should submit a title, a short abstract, and an extended abstract (max 4 A4 pages), and up to 3 keywords. The extended abstract must be sufficiently detailed to allow the organizers to judge the merits of the paper, including a clear description of the research question, the theoretical framework, the data, research design and research methodology, as well as the main findings. It should be max. 4 A4 pages, including tables and figures.
