

Welcome to the Department of Statistics! We are your Programmes Support Team and will be in touch regularly with advice and information about the Department and your programme.

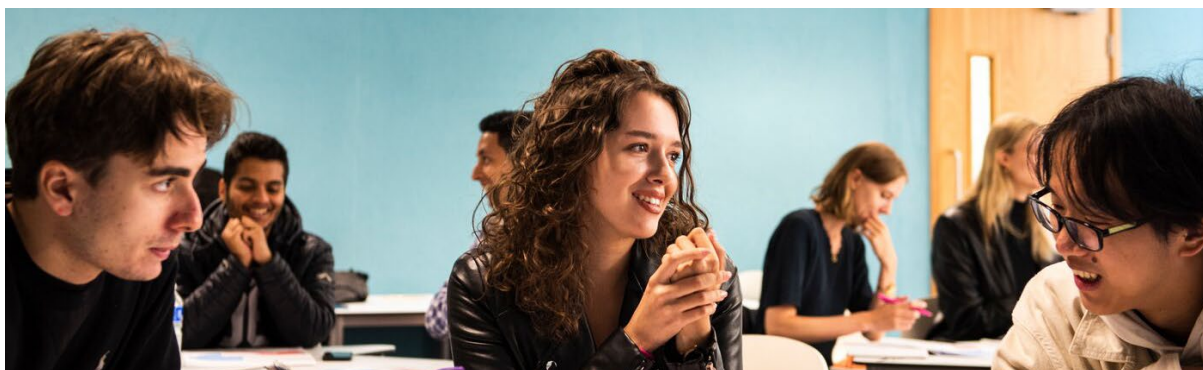
