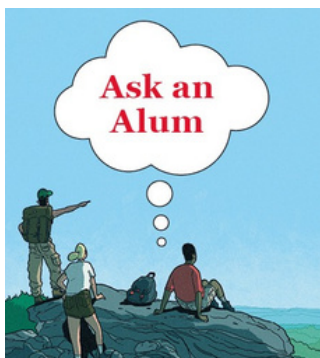


LSE Public Events

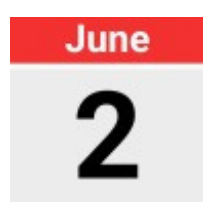

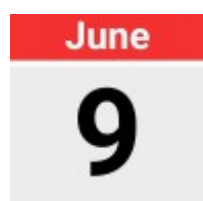
Mark your calendar

For offer holders with Home fee status, the deadline for receipt of [LSE Undergraduate Scholarship applications](#) is 2 June 2025. All scholarship decisions will be made and communicated by the end of August 2025.



Accommodation application deadline
