What is LSE100?

LSE100 is a half-unit interdisciplinary course that you will take in your first year of your degree. Through research-rich education, LSE100 equips you with the skills to tackle multidimensional problems, fostering critical thinking and collaboration for the betterment of society.

Choosing your LSE100 theme

Before arriving at LSE, you'll be asked to select one of these three compelling themes as the focus of your LSE100 studies:

- How can we control Al?
- How can we transform our climate futures?
- How can we create a fair society?

We encourage you to select a theme that sparks your curiosity and enthusiasm. You don't need prior expertise in your chosen theme; our seminars will support you in developing your knowledge throughout the course.

When can I select my theme?

You'll select your theme during the online pre-enrolment process later in the summer, before arriving on campus. For more details about each theme and how to make your choice, visit the LSE100 Welcome page and remember to join an Ask the LSE100 Co-Directors online session.

How will I study in LSE100?

LSE100 takes place across the Autumn and Winter terms of your first year as an undergraduate student. During your time on the course, you'll attend fortnightly interactive seminars where you'll get to engage with peers who are also studying your chosen theme.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment in LSE100 is based on two key components: an individual written assessment (worth 50% of your grade) in Autumn Term, and a group research project (also worth 50%) presented and submitted collectively at the end of Winter Term.
