**LSE Insight** is a one-day virtual event for year 11 students from UK state schools who are beginning to think about their post-16 and university options.

## Why take part?

Students will have the chance to:

- explore what university study is like at a world leading institution
- hear directly from LSE students, academics, and admissions specialists
- learn about LSE's widening participation opportunities
- gain confidence in planning next steps.

The programme includes a student panel, a social sciences taster lecture, an introduction to LSE admissions, and practical guidance on choosing post-16 options.
