CIVICA Engage Track

- Provides access to some of the best teaching institutions in Europe.
- Offers a European multi-campus, interdisciplinary bachelor experience with a focus on civic engagement.
- Enables students to highlight their commitment to civic issues and do good together with a diverse set of ambitious students from all over Europe.
- Exchange locations at LSE partners in **Italy, France, Spain, Austria, Sweden, Poland, and Romania**



How does it work?

- ❑ As part of your degree, take an Engage course at LSE
- ❑ Complete 'Showcase Assignment' (This will need to be completed BEFORE any travel)
- ❑ Take an Engage Course at a partner university on your exchange year abroad OR participate in 'European Week'

How to apply

- ❑ Applications are live on LSE CIVICA Engage Track website on Monday, 20 October 2025 and will be open until 9th November 2025.
- ❑ If your application is successful and you have selected to study abroad as part of this programme, you will be directed to apply with GO LSE to select your preferences for your exchange location.
- ❑ Available CIVICA exchange partners are **ONLY in Europe**, University of California is not an eligible exchange partner in the CIVICA Engage Track Programme.

CIVICA Engage Eligibility, Fees and Funding

- If applying to the year-long CIVICA Engage **exchange** stream, eligibility will be similar to other exchanges (i.e., open to 2nd year undergraduate students or 3rd year PPE students)
- If applying to the CIVICA Engage **European Week** stream, eligibility is broader and open to students who are currently in Year 1 too
- Students must ensure they have enough time to complete the entire CIVICA Engage track within two years of being accepted onto the programme

- Students completing the year-long **exchange** stream will have the same fees arrangements and access to funding as our other year-long exchanges.
- Students completing the **European Week** stream will be given CIVICA bursary funding to cover their return transport from London, accommodation and subsistence.
