



GOVERNMENT OF THE KYRGYZ REPUBLIC

DECREE

21 September 2018, No. 334-p (r)

In order to ensure the implementation of the United Nations Security Council Resolution 1325:

1. To approve the Action Plan for the implementation of Resolution 1325 of the United Nations Security Council on the role of women in ensuring peace and security (hereinafter referred to as the Action Plan) in accordance with the Annex.
2. To the ministries, state committees, administrative departments, local state administrations, local governments (upon their agreement):
 - ensure the implementation of the Action Plan;
 - based on the results of the first half year, no later than the 15th day of the month following the reporting period, to provide information on the implementation of the Action Plan to the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic;
 - to finance the activities of the Action Plan at the expense of funds provided for by the government bodies and local authorities involved in its implementation, according to the laws of the Kyrgyz Republic "On the state budget of the Kyrgyz Republic for 2018 and the forecast for 2019-2020", as well as other sources not prohibited by law of Kyrgyz Republic;
 - take measures to implement the Action Plan with participation of representatives of civil society, international and non-profit organizations.

3. Following the results of each half year, no later than the 25th day of the month following the reporting period, the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Kyrgyz Republic should submit final report to the Office of Government of the Kyrgyz Republic.

4. To recognize invalid the order of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic dated by 17 November 2015 No. 560-p (r).

5. Control over the implementation of this decree shall be entrusted to the Department of Defense, Law Enforcement and Emergency Situations of the Office of Prime Minister of the Kyrgyz Republic.
